<i>Bismillah er-Raḥmān er-Raḥeem</i>	In the name of Allāh, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful.
<i>Al-Ḥamd-o Lil-laahi Rab-bil 'Ālameen</i>	Praise is to Allāh, the Lord (Cherisher and Sustainer) of the worlds
<i>Ar-Raḥmān er-Raḥeem</i>	The Most Gracious, the Most Merciful;
<i>Māliki Yawm-id-deen</i>	The Master of the Day of Judgement
<i>Ey-yāka Na 'bod, wa-Ey-yāka Nasta 'een</i>	We worship you, and we seek help/aid from you
<i>Ehdinal-Ṣirāṭal-Mostaqem</i>	Guide us to The Right Path
<i>Ṣirāṭal-Ladheena An 'amta 'Alayhim, Ghayril-Maghḍoob-e 'Alayhim, walaḍ-ḍāl-leen.</i>	The path of those on whom you have bestowed Your Grace, Not (the path of) those who have incurred your wrath, Nor (those who) have gone astray.

Surah of Tawḥeed (Oneness), surah #112

<i>Bismillah er-Raḥmān er-Raḥeem</i>	In the name of Allāh, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful.
<i>Qul Huwa-llāh-u Aḥad</i>	Say: "He is Allāh, the only One
<i>Allāhus-Ṣamad</i>	Allāh, the Absolute Master
<i>Lam Yalid, wa Lam Youlad</i>	He does not beget, and nor was He begotten
<i>Wa Lam Yakon Lahu Kofowan Aḥad.</i>	And there is not a one His equal.

And there cannot be for Him an equal.
